### Meeting

1. New Items for the MCR
  - A wii is suggested by Josh
  - A mirror for the MCR (full length)

  - Money to provide incentives for people to be more green
  - An additional fridge in Barton road: this was looked into by college but nothing has happened yet. This will not come out of MCR funds but **Josh** will chase it up.
  - An MCR computer: we are not sure of the need for this.
  - A printer in accommodation: apparently this has been tried before but it was never used. If this happened the MCR would cover the cost of the machine with printing bills charged to individual people's bills. Charles believes we would probably also need a stand-alone computer next to the printer in order to charge people properly.
  - A Netflix account for the MCR: we are already getting sky and buying up DVDs so Netflix probably isn't necessary on top of all this.
